⁽¹⁾ *Math courses shall consist of Algebra I, Geometry, Algebra II (or its equivalent) and an additional course with significant math content.*

⁽²⁾ *Biology, Chemistry, and Physical Science, or Physics (higher level science may be substituted.)*

⁽³⁾ *American History required*

⁽⁴⁾ *Must be the same language*

Applicants must also meet at least one of the following:

- *Top 25% in high school graduating class*
- *3.0 GPA in competency courses (4.0 = A)*
- *ACT 22 (24 nonresidents)**
- *SAT Reasoning 1040 (1110 nonresidents)**

It is recommended that students take the SAT and/or ACT the spring of their junior year in high school. The PSAT is a practice test for the SAT. The PSAT is used to determine the National Merit Scholarships. It is given in October and should be taken during the junior year in high school.
