Purpose

Through the ministry team, students will learn to apply and grow in servant-leadership while ministering at KEYS. Those participating in the fine arts are able to serve through music, art, and drama. The KEYS Ministry Team creates opportunities for those students who would prefer to serve by setting-up, cleaning-up, doing yard work, babysitting, helping in the coffee bar, etc.

Policy

It is highly recommended that high school team members complete at least 16 ministry hours per semester. These hours may be performed on a weekly basis or during one-time events. Before the start of classes in the fall, students will advise the coordinator of their service preference and hours of availability and work with the coordinator to find their place on the KEY Ministry Team. Ministry hours are to be recorded and handed in each semester to the coordinator, Jackie Smith. It is the responsibility of the student to make sure his/her commitment is fulfilled each semester.

Perks

By being a part of the KEYS Ministry Team students not only develop their gifts and provide much needed services, they also become actively involved in the KEYS student body. Ministry hours can also be counted toward community service on high school transcripts, future college and scholarship applications, as well as job resumes. At the end of each academic year, team members will receive a certificate documenting their participation on the KEYS Ministry Team.
