



K.E.Y.S. of Arizona Release of Liability Waiver

In order to register your student(s) with K.E.Y.S. of AZ, you must agree to all the terms and conditions set forth in this Release and Liability Waiver. By signing the following Release and Liability Waiver, you, the Parent and/or Legal Guardian, agree to the following terms and conditions and understand that your student will be asked to sign and adhere to all of the policies outlined in the K.E.Y.S Student Covenant.

As the Parent and/or Legal Guardian of all my registered student(s), I hereby release K.E.Y.S. of AZ, West Thunderbird Community Care, and Christ's Community Church, located at 4530 W. Thunderbird Rd., Glendale, Arizona 85306, their leaders, their chapter, officers, directors, members, employees, private contractors, and all volunteers from any and all liability for damage or injury (whether caused by negligence or otherwise) to my child or myself, or to any person or property during the time of my child's attendance at K.E.Y.S. of AZ sponsored events from any claims, including the cost of expenses arising in connection with injuries or damages sustained by my child, me, or any member of my family, and I hereby expressly assume the risk of any such injuries or damages. This Release and Liability Waiver also operates as a Covenant not to sue.

Furthermore, I assume full responsibility for my child's conduct and for any damage or injury caused by my child(ren)'s actions.

By registering my child(ren) for any group tutoring class with K.E.Y.S. of AZ, I understand that I am liable for the non-refundable registration fee and the *entire semester of tuition* per class if classes are dropped on or after the first day of the semester, regardless of my child's/children's attendance. I also understand that tutoring fees are due on the 1st of each month from September through March. In compliance with the K.E.Y.S. Terms and Conditions, I agree to pay an \$11.00 per class late fee if my tutoring fees are received on or after the 6th of each month. If tutoring fees are more than one month in arrears, cumulative late fees apply. I also understand that my student will not be permitted to attend class until payment is received unless prior payment arrangements have been made.

Attendance at K.E.Y.S. is a privilege. The K.E.Y.S. Board of Directors maintains the right to accept or deny any student. The K.E.Y.S. Board of Directors also maintains the right to suspend, drop, or expel any student at any time for any reason.
